




## WHO CONTROLS THE BMC?

### THE MAYOR

- The nominal pointer of who controls the BMC is the mayor and his/her party
- Though largely ceremonial, the post is considered prestigious and reflects the numerical superiority of the party in the BMC's general body
- The mayor will be elected in the first general body meeting of the new corporators in the first week of March

➤ If BJP (82 seats) and Shiv Sena (84) have a post-poll alliance, a common candidate put up by them will comfortably win. The winning candidate requires 114 votes

- Complications will begin if the two parties do not join hands. If the Sena takes the support of Congress, it could beat the BJP in the mayoral race

### THE STATUTORY COMMITTEES

- The real power of the corporators is expressed through the four statutory bodies that are selected next – like the Standing Committee, the Improvements Committee, etc – according to proportional representation. It means members are elected based on the strength of each party

➤ The standing committee has 26 members, plus chairman. Sena with 84 corporators could get 10 members while the BJP with 82 corporators can get 9 on the panel. The same formula will be used to elect members of other statutory committees like Improvements, Education and BEST committees.

BEST committee has 17 members

- With proportional representation, the Shiv Sena will have a thin advantage in all of them
