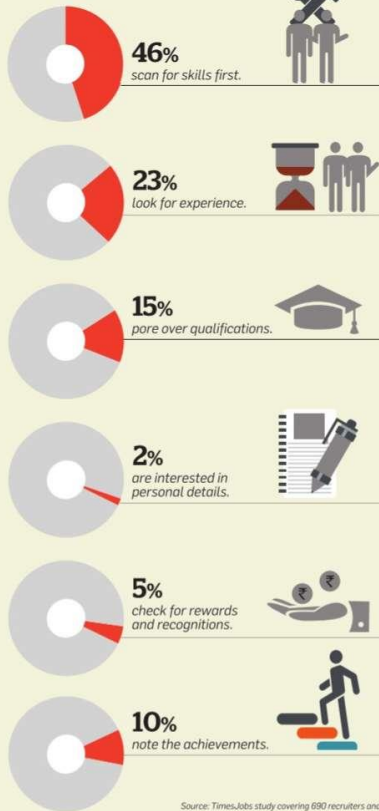
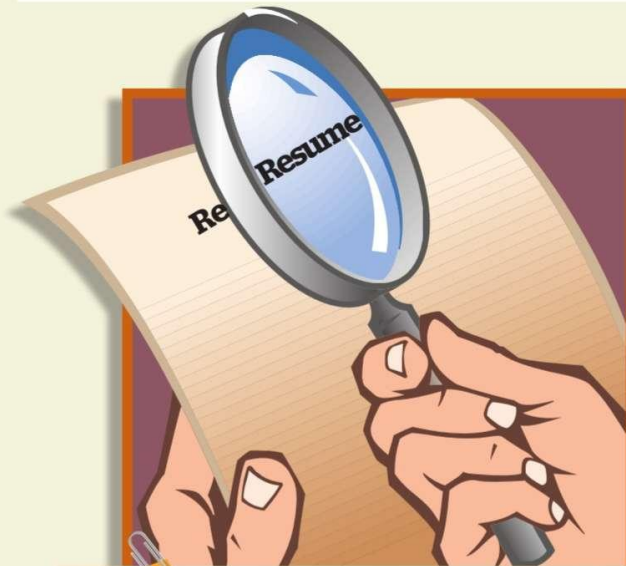


What recruiters look for first

These points are critical if you want your application shortlisted



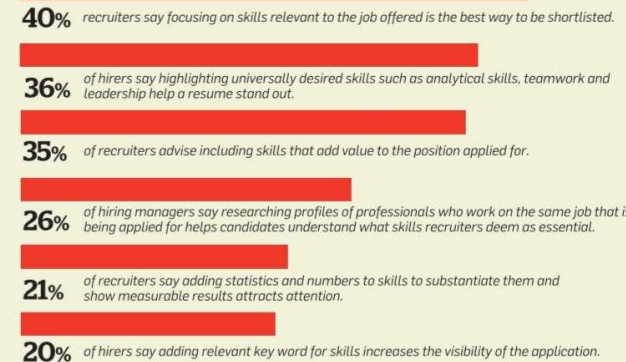
